# **USG Exchange Programs**

The Public Diplomacy Section administers a broad range of educational exchange programs sponsored by the U.S. Department of State

Who? Undergraduate and graduate students, professionals, secondary educators,

faculty, scholars, educational institutions can apply.

Where? Applications are submitted online. Each program has a deadline.

**How?** Participants are selected through a merit-based open competition or on nomination.

Most programs have three stages of selection: Application review, interview, tests

The U.S. Government grants cover all costs, including local/international travel, visa, and

living costs in the United States.

# Fulbright African Research Scholar Program





#### Fulbright African Research Scholar Program

**Overview** Research grants and program and curriculum development grants

for advanced research, university lecturing, and curriculum

development activities at U.S. academic institutions.

**Target Audience** University faculty, government officials, private sector professional,

professionals at think tanks

Eligibility Criteria

Masters or Doctoral degree

Cameroonian citizen

English language proficiency

**Program Duration** One semester (3-5 months) or one academic year (9 months)



#### **Fulbright ARSP Program Details**

#### **Research Grants**

- Awards of 3 to 9 months
- Must hold a doctorate or equivalent terminal degree
- Have at least three years of university teaching experience and a productive scholarly record

#### Program & Curriculum Development Grants

- Awards of 3 to 5 months
- Must hold a minimum of a master's or equivalent graduate degree
- For university faculty or administrators with less experience and less access to professional development
- Goal is to develop new courses, curricula, or other academic programs



#### Fulbright ARSP Application Components

- Online application
- Project proposal
- Bibliography
- Curriculum vitae
- Letters of recommendation (3)
- Letter of invitation from U.S. Host institution (preferred, but not required)



# Hubert H. Humphrey Fellowship





#### **Hubert H. Humphrey Fellowship**

Overview

Practical, professional development experiences and non-degree academic study at U.S. academic institutions in one of four fields of study: (1) sustainable lands, (2) rights and freedoms, (3) human and institutional capacity, or (4) thriving communities.

**Target Audience** 

Accomplished professionals at a mid-point in their careers

**Eligibility Criteria** 

- Bachelors' degree
- Cameroonian citizen
- English language proficiency
- Five years of professional experience
- Demonstrated leadership qualities
- A record of public service in the community

Program Duration

10 months

**Target Audience** Mid-career, typically between the ages of 30-50, highly motivated,

experienced scholars and professionals generally from institutions of

higher education or research focused organizations.

Eligibility Criteria

- Cameroonian citizen
- English language proficiency
- Firm plans to enhance, update or develop courses and/or educational materials with a U.S. studies focus or component

**Program Duration** Six weeks

English language proficiency

Bachelors Degree

Five years of experience

**Program Duration** Six weeks

### Fulbright Foreign Student Program

**Overview** Merit-based scholarship program which recruits and nominates

young Cameroonian professionals for graduate level studies at U.S.

universities.

**Target Audience** Young professionals with a depth and breadth of work experience in

their intended field of study

**Eligibility Criteria** • Equivalent of a U.S. Bachelors degree

Cameroonian citizen or permanent resident

English language proficiency

**Program Duration** Maximum of two years of degree study.
