The Joint Master in Microbiology and Parasitology with Gannan Medical University, China
at the Faculty of Medicine and Pharmaceutical Sciences in Cameroon

The Rector of the University of Dschang informs the public that during the 2025/2026 academic year, recruitment of **06 Master students** is opened into the first year of the 3-year Master program in **Microbiology and Parasitology** at the Faculty of Medicine and Pharmaceutical Sciences. The 3-year Joint Master program in *Microbiology and Parasitology* with Gannan Medical University, China hosted by the University of Dschang. Within the framework of this project, the Vice-Chancellor of the University of Dschang invites applications from highly motivated and dedicated among the previous selected master students in clinical biology and public health following the announcement N06989/UDS/R/VR-EPTIC/DAAC/FMSP.

Master Project's Description in Microbiology and Parasitology

Malaria, helminthiasis, and Bacterial infections, remain major public health challenges in many countries across Asia and Africa, contributing to high morbidity, mortality, and socio-economic burden. Folk medicine resources including medicinal plants, fungi, and other natural products have long been used by local communities to prevent and treat these infections. These resources are a rich source of bioactive compounds with potential antimicrobial and antiparasitic activities, yet their efficacy, safety, and mechanisms of action remain largely unexplored. The **main objective of this project** is to evidence the antibiotic resistance of parasite and bacteria as well as to investigate the antiparasitic and antimicrobial activities of folk medicine resources and elucidate their resistance mechanisms and active compounds against Bacterial AMR, resistance *Plasmodium* species, or helminths. The study will involve ethnobotanical surveys to identify widely used remedies, collection and preparation of extracts, and evaluation of their activity through in vitro and in vivo assays.



Chemical characterization of active compounds will be conducted, alongside mechanistic studies and safety assessments, to identify candidates suitable for further therapeutic development. By integrating traditional knowledge with modern scientific approaches, this project aims to design and develop novel drug, effective, and safe natural compounds for the prevention and treatment of bacterial infections, malaria, and helminthiasis in endemic regions. The findings will provide a scientific basis for the rational use of folk medicine resources and contribute to evidence-based strategies for combating infectious diseases.

1. Eligibility Criteria

Master program in Microbiology and parasitology: A Bachelor degree in Biomedical Sciences, in Medical Laboratory Sciences, in Biochemistry, in Animal Biology, or in Immunology, A Diploma in Medico-Sanitary Engineer, a Doctorate degree in Medicine, Pharmacy or Veterinary Medicine.

What does Gannan Medical University offer?

- You will be fully registered at UDs and GMU for the entire duration of your degree and stay at GMU for at least 2 years (primarily for experimental work or clinical training).
- GMU will provide a scholarship of 8000 CNY per year to cover part of your tuition fees (18000 CNY/year) and of 4,000 CNY per year to cover accommodation at GMU.
- The traveling fees is self-funded, as well as approximately 400 CNY (\approx 32000 Franc CFA) for the visa fee, 800 CNY (\approx 64000 Franc CFA) for the insurance fee, and 300 CNY (\approx 24000 Franc CFA) for the medical examination fee every year in China. Living expenditure and other miscellaneous fee will be self-funded.
- The flight ticket will be self-funded by the candidate.


1. An application form downloaded and printed during the online pre-registration on the university website: www.univ-dschang.org or on the platform <http://sigesonline.univ-dschang.org>;
2. A certified copy of birth certificate;
3. A certificate of non-conviction;
4. A certified copy of the Baccalaureate or GCE or any equivalent diploma;
5. A certified photocopy of the diploma giving access to the applied Master's degree;
6. Certified copies of transcripts of university academic years;
7. A detailed curriculum vitae;
8. A certificate of employment, if applicable, signed by the employer;
9. A medical certificate delivered by a medical doctor from a public health institution;
10. 04 color passport size photographs (4x4) with name and surname written overleaf;
11. A letter of motivation addressed to the Dean of the FMPS indicating the professional project of the candidate (01 page maximum);
12. A letter of commitment on honour addressed to the dean mentioning systematic attendance at all lectures during the two academic years;
13. The receipt for payment of the amount of 20,000 CFA (non-refundable) representing the application fees. This amount is payable upon presentation of a downloaded payment slip, at the authorized financial institution chosen during the online application procedure;
14. A stamped envelope bearing the address of the candidate.
15. English proficiency certificate (or proof of fluent English communication, certificate of Bilingualism)
16. Two recommendation letters from lecturers or professors

- Candidates will be interviewed at the main building of the FMSP according to the following schedule (first interview) and online interview by GMU (second interview)
